

# How to authorize COF (College Opportunity Fund)

1. From <https://www.pikespeak.edu/> - in top right corner, click on “MyPikesPeak Portal Login”




2. Log in using your student number including the capital S and the minimum 14-character password you created.

3. Once in your student portal, on your main Dashboard, locate Student Finance card and click on “College Opportunity Fund (COF)”



4. Ensure the current term is selected from the dropdown menu and click “Submit”



5. The courses you’re currently enrolled in should be listed on this page, and there should 3 options listed as a **Student Authorization Response**

## College Opportunity Fund Authorization



The College Opportunity Fund (COF) is the state paid portion of your tuition.

- Your COF authorization is a lifetime authorization that does not require reauthorization every term.
- Your COF authorization or decline can be changed in the future by returning to this page and choosing a different response.
- If you would like to accept state money (COF) to reduce your bill, select the “I choose to Authorize” option below.
- If you choose to decline the COF stipend, you will be required to pay both the student and state portions of your tuition.
- After submitting your choice, click the “Registration Menu” link at the bottom of the page and continue to register.
