






#### Tuition & Fees

At Pikes Peak, you get a quality education for a fraction of the cost—saving an average of \$10,000 if you are planning to transfer to another college or university. The graph below is a comparison of in-state tuition for two semesters at 15 credits per semester.






## Technical and Professional Studies


