

Veteran participants are needed for a research study on eye movement control and brain imaging in military Veterans with prior mild traumatic brain injury compared to Veterans without history of brain injury

You may be eligible to participate if you:

- are a military Veteran
- are between the ages of 18 and 65 years
- do not have clinically defined significant eye disease

Research study involvement:

- all eligible participants are asked to attend a visit for approximately 3.5 hours on the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus
- complete an eye exam
- complete two computerized tests of eye movement
- complete two neuropsychological measures and a survey of posttraumatic stress
- undergo brain MR imaging
- compensation provided for participants who complete all testing
