Additional Comments:

1. Military students need to designate themselves as "military" on the school application so that attributes may be entered. This designation will allow the student to be charged the \$750 cap of tuition assistance (TA) instead of the normal \$263.20 (per credit hour) tuition price.

2. ZTC - Zero textbook cost: there are no textbook fees if you are enrolled in a ZTC CCCOnline course. Required 2021-2022 academic school year books are free. Other learning items such as hardware, software, lab kits, and recommended reading materials (if desired) must be purchased by the student. Existing PPCC Digital Course Materials (E-Book) fees will be waived during the applicable semesters. CCCO Digital Course Fees (DCF) cannot be waived, but students will be reimbursed for CCCO DCFs on their student bill after the drop date.

3. An instructional fee of \$7.20 per credit hour is charged to the student.
