How to Order

Online

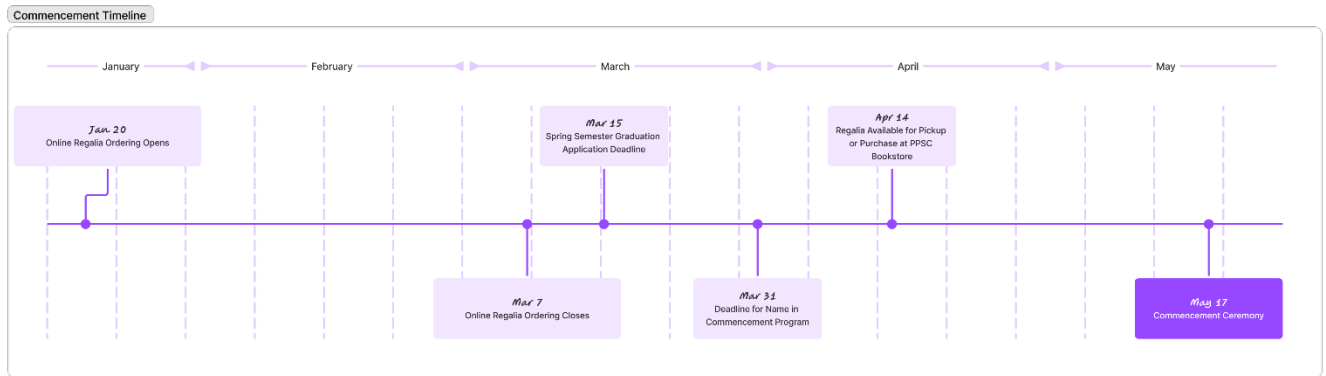

Online orders will arrive at the Centennial Campus Bookstore and be available for pickup starting the week of April 14, 2025. The bookstore will call you when your regalia has arrived.

In-person

Size Guide

OAK HALL CAP & GOWN SIZE CHART

Height	Weight
4'9" – 4'11"	Up to 130 lbs.
5' – 5'2"	Up to 150 lbs.
5'3" – 5'5"	Up to 170 lbs.
5'6" – 5'8"	Up to 250 lbs.
5'9" – 5'11"	Up to 275 lbs.
6' – 6'2"	Up to 300 lbs.
6' – 6'5"	Up to 325 lbs.
Plus 1* 4'9" – 5'5"	Over 200 lbs.
Plus 2* 5'6" – 5'11"	Over 275 lbs.
Plus 3* 6' – 6'5"	Over 325 lbs.

*NOTE: The Plus size gown will comfortably fit a bust/waist/hip measurement of 72". If you do not need this much width in the body of the gown, but your weight is slightly higher than the ranges listed above, order the next gown length, i.e., instead of 5'3"-5'5", order size 5'6"-5'8".

Cords, Stoles and Medallions

For student clubs, organizations, and programs, contact your club advisors for information about cords and stoles.

Honor Cords are distributed during commencement check-in. Make sure to verify your GPA to ensure you receive the correct cord for your academic achievement:

- Graduating with highest honor, Summa Cum Laude - 4.0 cumulative GPA
- Graduating with great honor, Magna Cum Laude - 3.75 - .399 cumulative GPA
- Graduating with honor, Cum Laude - 3.5 - 3.749 cumulative GPA

Students earning a bachelor's degree will also receive a special recognition cord.
