How to Order

Online


It is **highly recommended** that you order your regalia online. Doing so helps ensure that you get the right size and package and allows for time to correct any potential issues that could arise. You can order online at <https://oakhallcg.com/pages/pikespeak>.

Online orders will arrive at the Centennial or Rampart Campus Bookstores based on your preference and be available for pickup starting the week of April 13, 2026. You will be notified via email when your regalia has arrived.

In-person

OAK HALL CAP & GOWN SIZE CHART

Height	Weight
4'9" – 4'11"	Up to 130 lbs.
5' – 5'2"	Up to 150 lbs.
5'3" – 5'5"	Up to 170 lbs.
5'6" – 5'8"	Up to 250 lbs.
5'9" – 5'11"	Up to 275 lbs.
6' – 6'2"	Up to 300 lbs.
6' – 6'5"	Up to 325 lbs.
Plus 1* 4'9" – 5'5"	Over 200 lbs.
Plus 2* 5'6" – 5'11"	Over 275 lbs.
Plus 3* 6' – 6'5"	Over 325 lbs.

*NOTE: The Plus size gown will comfortably fit a bust/waist/hip measurement of 72". If you

do not need this much width in the body of the gown, but your weight is slightly higher than the ranges listed above, order the next gown length, i.e., instead of 5'3-5' 5", order size 5 '6-5 '8".

Cords, Stoles and Medallions

For student clubs, organizations, and programs, contact your club or program advisors for information about cords and stoles.

Honor Cords are distributed during commencement check-in. **Make sure to verify your cumulative GPA prior to Commencement check-in** to ensure you receive the correct cord for your academic achievement:

- Graduating with highest honor, Summa Cum Laude - 4.0 cumulative GPA (Gold cord)
- Graduating with great honor, Magna Cum Laude - 3.75 – 3.99 cumulative GPA (Navy cord)
- Graduating with honor, Cum Laude - 3.5 - 3.749 cumulative GPA (Lime cord)
