

Colorado Springs Student Rider Information

This packet contains all the information that you will need to set you up for a successful ride along with Apex Paramedics. Please read the packet in its entirety prior to your ride along.

Ride Along Location

Your ride along will be at Apex Paramedics Springs station.

The station is located at

2270 West Garden of the Gods Road #101,

Colorado Springs CO, 80907

You can park anywhere in the parking lot in front of the building.

You will enter through the employee entrance on the south side of the building labeled "Apex Paramedics"

Gaining Access to the Building

To get in the building you will contact our on duty field supervisor at (720) 354-2385.

You will let the field supervisor know that you are a student at the Springs station for a ride along and are outside the employee entrance and they will be able to let you in the building remotely.

Please do not contact the field supervisor to gain entry into the building anymore than 10 minutes prior to your ride along. If you are too early the crew you are riding with may not have arrived yet. The supervisor will not let you in any earlier than 10 minutes before your ride along.

If you have arrived before the crew you will be riding with just wait in the common area. You will find the common area just inside the building straight ahead from the employee entrance.

If you are more than 15 minutes late to your ride along the crew will leave without you and you will need to contact your instructor to reschedule your ride along.

What to Bring

While on your ride along plan to be on the ambulance for the entirety of the shift. While it is a possibility that you will get a chance to stop at a EMS lounge during your shift it is not a guarantee.

Outside of what your school requires you to bring there are a few things we recommend you bring as well. We recommend you bring a jacket, a way to take notes, a water bottle, and a snack or lunch in case you do not get a chance to stop at a lounge. There will be plenty of room on the ambulance to store your personal belongings.
