1. Tuition & Fees

- Cost per NUR credit hour
 - Resident: \$370.40
 - Non-Resident: \$710
- Total estimated tuition (3 semesters with a total of 36 credits)
 - Resident: \$13,334.40
 - Non-Resident: \$25,560
- Mandatory college fees (e.g., technology, student services, course fees)
 - First Year: \$754.41

2. Course Materials & Supplies

- Textbooks (estimated cost per year):
 - First Year: \$866.89
- Online learning resources (Docucare, ATI testing Materials, etc.): \$1,356.27

3. Clinical & Lab Fees

- Lab equipment usage fees: \$1,415.62
- Clinical site requirements: \$1,612.02

4. Exam & Licensing Costs

- NCLEX-PN exam fee: \$200
- Background check & fingerprinting: \$30-\$75
- Colorado Licensing application fees: \$123

5. Additional Expenses

- Health requirements (vaccinations, TB test, Tdap, MMR, etc): \$760
- CPR certification: \$60-\$80
